Paper I - (200 marks)

Duration : Two hours

- Current events of national and international importance.
- History of India and Indian National Movement.
- Indian and World Geography-Physical, Social, Economic Geography of India and the World.
- Indian Polity and Governance-Constitution, Political System, Panchayati Raj, Public Policy, Rights Issues, etc.
- Economic and Social Development-Sustainable Development, Poverty, Inclusion, Demographics, Social Sector Initiatives, etc.
- General issues on Environmental ecology, Bio-diversity and Climate Change - that do not require subject specialization.
- General Science.

Paper II-(200 marks)

Duration : Two hours

- Comprehension;
- Interpersonal skills including communication skills;
- Logical reasoning and analytical ability;
- Decision making and problem solving;
- General mental ability;
- Basic numeracy (numbers and their relations, orders of magnitude, etc.) (Class X level), Data interpretation (charts, graphs, tables, data sufficiency etc. — Class X level);

 - Holistic awareness of the Syllabus of Prelims, Mains & Personality Test
 - Previous Year Questions(PYQs)
- Study Material
 - Basic reading of core books of main subjects
 - Prelims v. Mains – difference in approach while studying same subject
 - Learning how to read - Books, Newspapers & Magazines and also learning the art of consuming digital contents.
- Answer Writing
 - Practicing PYQs and Test Papers (Pre & Mains)

UNDERSTAND YOURSELF

- Optional Subject selection
 - Expertise
 - Interest
 - Scoring potential
 - Utility
- Learning, memory and retention
 - Learning the art of making 3- tier notes (Raw Notes => Synopsis=> Short Notes)
 - Use 3Rs Policy i.e. REVISE - RETAIN – REPLICATE
- Time Management
 - Marathon, not a sprint
 - Use micro planning to manage time well and don't make long term plans
